TENSION SQUARE

19 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over reverse stockinette stitch, using P. IRLANDAIS and 4.5 mm needles
22 sts to 9 cm and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch, using P. IRLANDAIS and 4.5 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs

Composition: 42% wool, 41% acrylic, 17% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 4 mm and 4.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
1 cable needle
Yarn needle
5 - 5 - 5 - 6 - 6 x 15 mm buttons, color DAIM, ref: 070 222 1170

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Reverse stockinette st (rev st st)

Pattern stitch (see chart)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and NATUREL, cast on 61 - 67 - 73 - 77 - 83 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K1 - K1 - P1 - P1 - K1

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and rev st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 18 - 20 - 22 - 25 - 27 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times
3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st twice

Total: 43 - 49 - 53 - 57 - 61 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 38 - 41 - 45 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

2 sts twice and 3 sts twice
3 sts 4 times
3 sts 3 times and 4 sts once
3 sts twice and 4 sts twice
4 sts 4 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 7 - 9 - 11 - 13 - 13 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts twice.

Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and NATUREL, cast on 31 - 33 - 36 - 38 - 41 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning the 1st row with K2 and ending with P1 - P1 - K1 - K1 - P1

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and pattern st, increasing 4 sts in the 1st row (refer to the chart).

Work as follows: 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 5 sts in rev st st, then the 22 sts in the chart and 11 - 12 - 14 - 15 - 18 sts in rev st st.

Total: 35 - 37 - 40 - 42 - 45 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 18 - 20 - 22 - 25 - 27 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times
3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times
3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st twice

Total: 26 - 28 - 30 - 32 - 34 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 28 - 32 - 35 - 38 - 42 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice
4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times
4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times
4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

Step 5: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 38 - 41 - 45 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

3 sts 3 times and 4 sts once
3 sts once and 4 sts 3 times
4 sts 4 times
4 sts 3 times and 5 sts once
4 sts once and 5 sts 3 times

Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping.

ARMHOLE EDGING

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and NATUREL, cast on 62 - 70 - 80 - 84 - 90 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

Make another band in the same way.

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and NATUREL, cast on 59 - 67 - 75 - 79 - 87 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2, then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

Make another band in the same way, but make 4 - 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 buttonholes (= yo and K2tog) in the 3rd row. Make the 1st buttonhole at 12 - 14 - 16 - 14 - 16 sts from the edge and the following buttonholes at intervals of 12 - 14 - 16 - 12 - 14 sts.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and NATUREL, cast on 65 - 69 - 75 - 79 - 79 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2 and making a buttonhole in the 4th row. Make the buttonhole (yo and K2tog) at 3 sts from the left edge. Then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder and side seams.

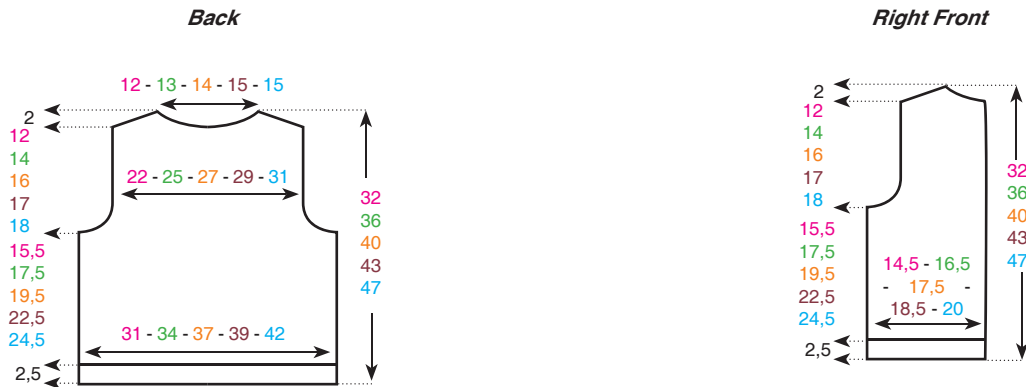
Step 2: Join the armhole edging, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

Step 3: Join the button bands along the front sections in the same way.

Step 4: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work; position the ends over the button bands.

Step 5: Sew the buttons.

Step 6: Using AUBERGINE, embroider the inside of each diamond in lazy daisy and straight st (see diagram).



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm

 = K1 (RS) or P1 (WS)

 = inc 1 st (= M1)

 or  = P1 (RS) or K1 (WS)

 = 2 sts crossed to the left (sl1 purlwise and P1): sl1 onto a cable needle placed in front of your work, P1, then slip the st on the cable needle purlwise (yarn behind the st).

 = 2 sts crossed to the right (P1 and sl1 purlwise): sl1 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, sl1 purlwise (yarn behind the st), then purl the st on the cable needle

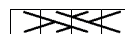
 = 4 sts crossed to the left (RS): sl2 onto a cable needle placed in front of your work, K2, then knit the 2 sts on the cable needle

Diagram for embroidery in AUBERGINE

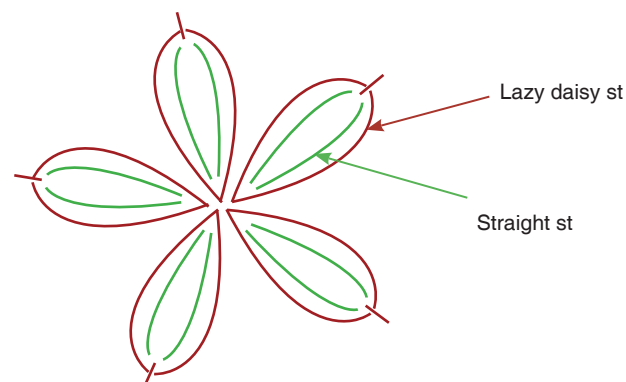


Chart for pattern st
