K1/P1 rib - Stockinette stitch - Jacquard

Single decrease at 1 st from the edge

Double decrease at 1 st from the edge

Duplicate stitch embroidery

Stem stitch, straight stitch and chain stitch embroidery

Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

26 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using 3 mm needles

Composition: 42% lambswool, 40% acrylic, 18% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch (st st)

Jacquard (see charts)

Single decrease at 1 st from the edge:

On the right: K1, then SKP (sl1 knitwise, K1, then psso)

On the left: work to the last 3 sts, K2tog, K1

Double decrease at 1 st from the edge:

On the right: K1, then SK2P (sl1 knitwise, K2tog, then psso)

On the left: work to the last 4 sts, K3tog, K1

Duplicate stitch embroidery: using CHOCOLAT, see chart for jacquard (inside the ears)

Stem stitch, straight stitch and chain stitch embroidery: see charts

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and FLANELLE, cast on 80 - 88 - 96 - 100 - 108 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 20 - 22 - 24 - 26 - 29 cm from the beginning, shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 3 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from the edge (see STITCHES) as follows:

dble dec once and sgld dec twice, repeat the sequence in **bold** 5 more times, then sgld dec twice

sgld dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then sgld dec 4 times

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then sgld dec twice

sgld dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, then sgld dec 5 times

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 5 more times, then sgld dec once

Step 4: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 22 - 24 - 26 - 28 - 28 sts.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and FLANELLE, cast on 80 - 88 - 96 - 100 - 108 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 5.5 - 8 - 6.5 - 8 - 10 cm from the beginning, continue in st st and jacquard (see charts) as follows:

25 sts in st st, the 30 sts in the jacquard chart and 25 sts in st st

29 sts in st st, the 30 sts in the jacquard chart and 29 sts in st st

30 sts in st st, the 36 sts in the jacquard chart and 30 sts in st st

32 sts in st st, the 36 sts in the jacquard chart and 32 sts in st st

36 sts in st st, the 36 sts in the jacquard chart and 36 sts in st st

When the 70 - 70 - 90 - 90 - 90 rows in the chart have been worked, continue in st st using FLANELLE.

Step 4: When your work measures 20 - 22 - 24 - 26 - 29 cm from the beginning, shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 3 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from the edge (see STITCHES) as follows:

dble dec once and sgld dec twice, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec once

sgld dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then sgld dec once

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec 3 times

sgld dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, then sgld dec twice

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec once

Step 5: When your work measures 29 - 33 - 36 - 39 - 40 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 14 - 16 - 16 - 16 - 18 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

3 sts once and 1 st once

3 sts once and 1 st once

3 sts once and 2 sts twice

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Step 6: When your work measures 30.5 - 34.5 - 38.5 - 41.5 - 45.5 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and FLANELLE, cast on 50 - 52 - 54 - 56 - 58 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and st st, increasing on each edge:

every 10 rows, inc 1 st 6 times, then 8 rows higher, inc 1 st once

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 10 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 8 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 11 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 9 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 8 times

Total: 64 - 72 - 80 - 84 - 92 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 24 - 27.5 - 31 - 34.5 - 38.5 cm from the beginning, start to shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 3 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from the edge (see STITCHES) as follows:

dble dec once and sgld dec twice, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec once

sgld dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then sgld dec once

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec 3 times

sgld dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, then sgld dec twice

dble dec once and sgld dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 4 more times, then dble dec once and sgld dec once

Step 4: On the right edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

7 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

7 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

At the same time, decrease at 1 st from the left edge: sgls dec once, then every 2 rows, sgls dec twice.

Step 5: When your work measures 36 - 41.5 - 47 - 51.5 - 56.5 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

Make the Left Sleeve, reversing all the shaping.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and FLANELLE, cast on 96 - 100 - 108 - 114 - 114 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm, then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Using CHOCOLAT, embroider the ears in duplicate st (see charts), then embroider the eyes, nose, mouth, hands and feet in straight st. Using CERISE and NAVAL, embroider the cap in stem st.

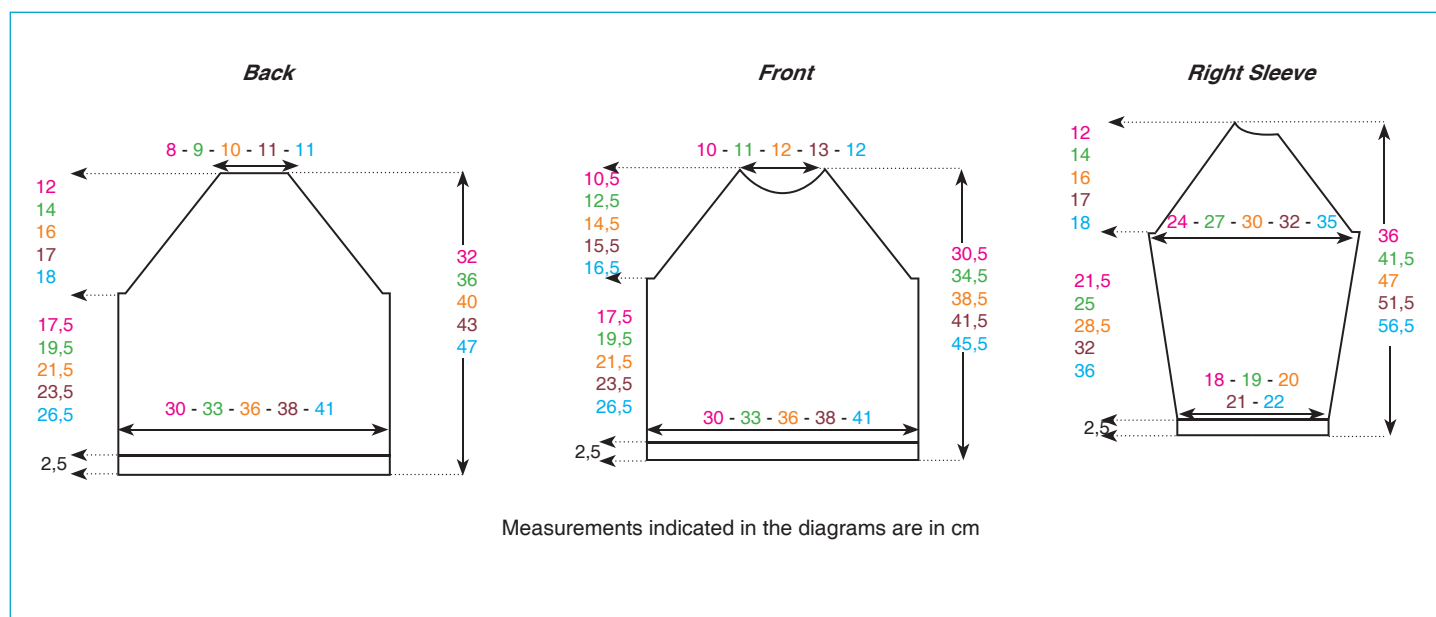
Using BLANC, embroider the pockets and the letter A in stem st, double the yarn and embroider the jacket in stem st, then the pants in chain st. Embroider a small stitch inside the eyes.

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body via the raglan (the shortest edge matches to the front).

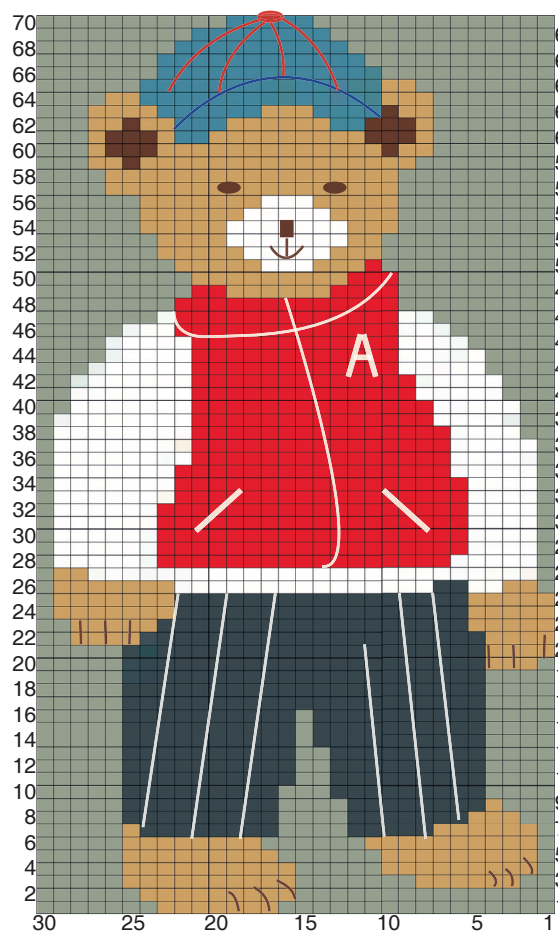
Step 3: Sew the side seams.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams.

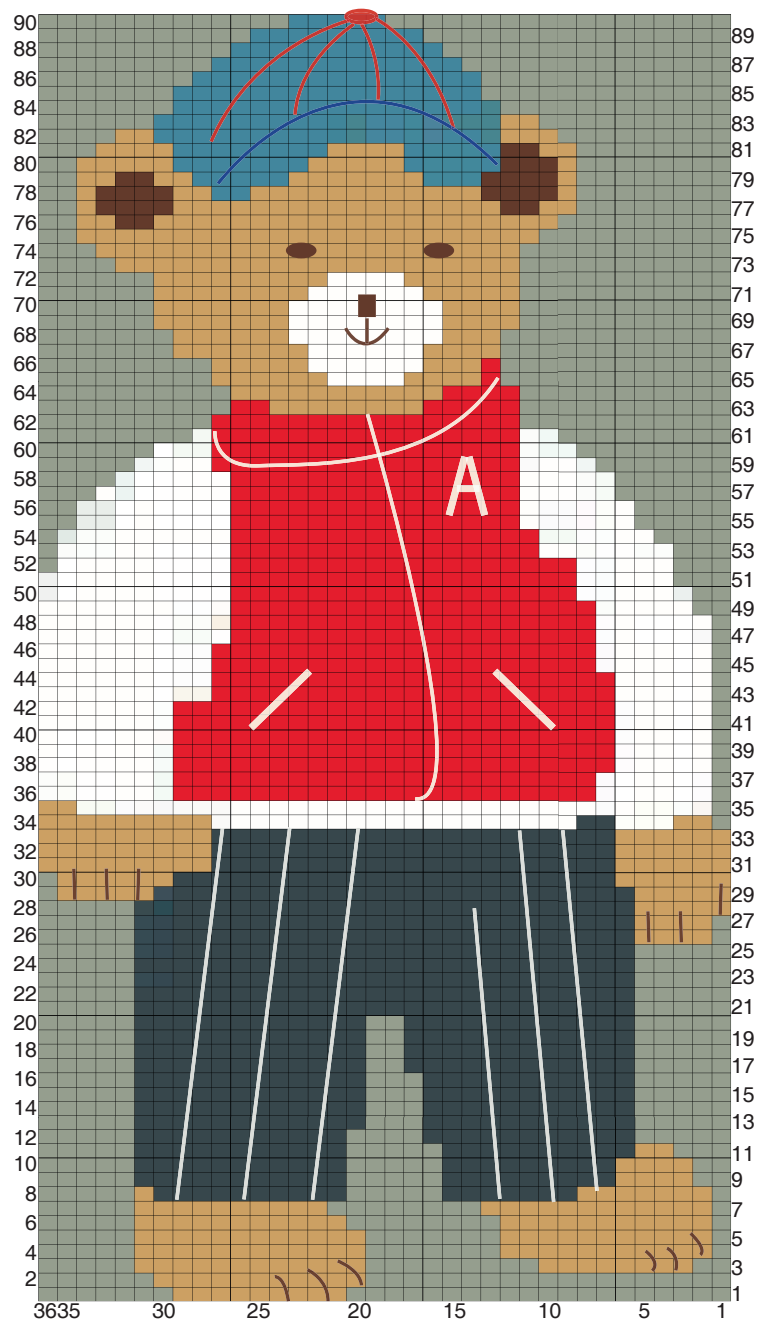
Step 5: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.
