Circular knitting

TENSION SQUARE

15 sts and 23 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using 6 mm needles

Version A (with embroidery)

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs

P. COTON 3	AMANDE	1	1	1	1	1

Composition: 40% alpaca, 35% polyamide, 25% cotton

Version B

Composition: 54% alpaca, 46% polyamide

Version C

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P. GIVRE COLOR LUREX	SORBET DENIM	2	2	3	3	3

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
5.5 mm and 6 mm circular needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

STITCHES:

Stockinette stitch (in rows): alternate knit 1 row, purl 1 row

Circular stockinette stitch: knit all the sts in each round

Circular K1/P1 rib: alternate K1, P1 to the end of the round

For the version in PRUSSE:

Embroidery in straight st and lazy daisy st: see diagram

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

Begin in rows of stockinette stitch (st st) for the top back down to the armholes, then pick up the stitches along one shoulder and shape one side of the front neck; work in the same way for the other shoulder and continue with the top front down to the armholes.

Finally, work on all the stitches in circular stockinette stitch for the main body.

TOP BACK

Step 1: Using a 6 mm circular needle, cast on 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts in PRUSSE or ULTRAVIOLET or SORBET DENIM.

Step 2: Place a marker after the:

16th st and the 34th st

17th st and the 37th st

18th st and the 40th st

19th st and the 43rd st

21st st and the 45th st

Step 3: Work in rows of st st for 13 - 15 - 17 - 18 - 19 cm.

Step 4: Leave these 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts on a holder and cut the yarn.

TOP FRONT

Step 1: Bring the cast-on row for the Top Back up to the top; using a 6 mm circular needle, pick up 16 - 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 sts along the back right shoulder (the sts before the 1st stitch marker).

Step 2: Purl 1 row (this row is not counted in the pattern), then work 4 rows of st st.

Step 3: Shape the neck. Increase at the **end** of the row as follows:

R1: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 1 st

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R6: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 1 st

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 3 sts

R6: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 1 st

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3 and R4: Repeat rows 1 and 2

R5: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R6: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R7: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 3 sts

R8: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 1 st

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5 et R6: Repeat rows 3 and 4

R7: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 3 sts

R8: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 1 st

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 2 sts

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5 et R6: Repeat rows 3 and 4

R7: Knit all the sts to the end of the row, then increase 3 sts

R8: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

Total: 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 sts

Leave these sts on a holder and cut the yarn.

Step 4: Using a 6 mm circular needle, pick up 16 - 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 sts along the back left shoulder, beginning at the 2nd stitch marker that indicates the end of the neck to the armhole.

Step 5: Purl 1 row (this row is not counted in the pattern), then work 4 rows of st st.

Step 6: Shape the neck. Increase at the **beginning** of the row as follows:

R1: Cast on 1 st, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Cast on 1 st, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R5: Cast on 3 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R1: Cast on 1 st, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row

R3 and R4: Repeat rows 1 and 2

R5: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

R6: Purl all the sts to the end of the row
 R7: Cast on 3 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R1: Cast on 1 st, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row
 R3: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row
 R5 and R6: Repeat rows 3 and 4
 R7: Cast on 3 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R1: Cast on 1 st, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R2: Purl all the sts to the end of the row
 R3: Cast on 2 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row
 R4: Purl all the sts to the end of the row
 R5 and R6: Repeat rows 3 and 4
 R7: Cast on 3 sts, then knit all the sts to the end of the row

Total: 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 sts. Do not cut the yarn.

Step 7: Purl the 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 sts for the front left shoulder, cast on 8 sts, then purl the 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 sts for the right shoulder (the sts left on a holder at Step 3).

Total: 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts

Step 8: Work in rows of st st until your work measures 13 - 15 - 17 - 18 - 19 cm from the beginning.

MAIN BODY

Now join the Top Back and Top Front in circular st st as follows.

Step 1: Place a stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round, then knit the 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts for the Top Front, then the 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts for the Top Back left on a holder.

Total: 100 - 108 - 116 - 124 - 132 sts

Step 2: Continue in circular st st on all these sts.

Step 3: When your work measures 29 - 33 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning (measured from the center back neck), change to a 5.5 circular needle and work in K1/P1 circular rib for 3 cm, then loosely bind off all the sts.

ARMHOLE EDGING

Step 1: Using a 5.5 mm circular needle, pick up 44 - 50 - 56 - 60 - 64 sts around the armhole. Place a marker at the beginning of the round and close the round, then work in K1/P1 circular rib.

Step 2: When your work measures 2.5 cm from the beginning, loosely bind off all the sts.

Step 3: Repeat steps 1 and 2 around the other armhole.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using a 5.5 mm circular needle, pick up 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 62 sts around the neck, beginning at the center of the back neck. Place a marker at the beginning of the round and close the round, then work in K1/P1 circular rib.

Step 2: When your work measures 3 cm from the beginning, loosely bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Weave in the ends on the wrong side of your work.

Step 2: For the version in PRUSSE, embroider 5 flowers around the front neck. Embroider in lazy daisy st using PRUSSE, then in straight st using AMANDE (see diagram and photo).

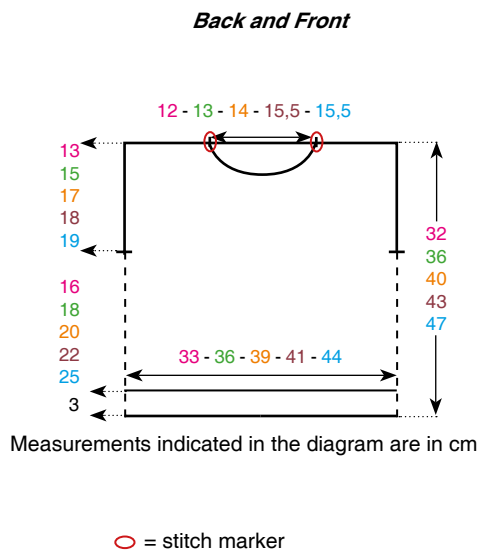


Diagram for the lazy daisy st embroidery in PRUSSE for version C
