Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

27 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over K1/P2 rib using 4 mm needles

Version A

Version B

Composition: 50% wool, 50% acrylic

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 3 mm and 4 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

K1/P2 rib

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ORCHIDEE (**version A**) or OURSON (**version B**), cast on 88 - 94 - 104 - 110 - 118 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm (7 rows), then purl 1 row on the wrong side of your work.

Step 2: Change to 4 mm needles and MAUVE (**version A**) or OUTREMER (**version B**). Work in K1/P2 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with P2, and increasing 1 - 1 - 1 st in this row.

Total: 89 - 95 - 104 - 110 - 119 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 19 - 21 - 23 - 25 - 28 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each edge to indicate the armholes.

Step 4: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

6 sts once and 7 sts 3 times

7 sts 3 times and 8 sts once

8 sts 4 times

8 sts twice and 9 sts twice

9 sts twice and 10 sts twice

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 23 - 25 - 28 - 30 - 31 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts once and 2 sts once.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ORCHIDEE (**version A**) or OURSON (**version B**), cast on 88 - 94 - 104 - 110 - 118 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm (7 rows), then purl 1 row on the wrong side of your work.

Step 2: Change to 4 mm needles and MAUVE (**version A**) or OUTREMER (**version B**). Work in K1/P2 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with P2, and increase 1 - 1 - 1 st in this row.

Total: 89 - 95 - 104 - 110 - 119 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 19 - 21 - 23 - 25 - 28 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each edge to indicate the armholes.

Step 4: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 21 - 23 - 24 - 26 - 27 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

Step 5: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

6 sts once and 7 sts 3 times

7 sts 3 times and 8 sts once

8 sts 4 times

8 sts twice and 9 sts twice

9 sts twice and 10 sts twice

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ORCHIDEE (**version A**) or OURSON (**version B**), cast on 52 - 56 - 58 - 58 - 62 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm (7 rows), then purl 1 row on the wrong side of your work.

Step 2: Change to 4 mm needles and MAUVE (**version A**) or OUTREMER (**version B**). Work in K1/P2 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with P2, and increase 1 - 1 - 1 st in this row.

Total: 53 - 56 - 59 - 59 - 62 sts

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 5 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 12 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 12 times, then every 4 rows, inc 1 st 4 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 12 times, then every 4 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 15 times, then every 4 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

Total: 69 - 80 - 91 - 97 - 102 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 24 - 28.5 - 33 - 37 - 40.5 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and OUTREMER (**version A**) or VERT (**version B**), cast on 88 - 94 - 102 - 108 - 114 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm.

Step 2: Knit 1 row on the right side, then work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

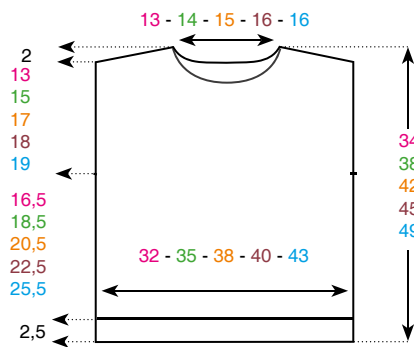
Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body between the marked sts at the Back and Front.

Step 3: Sew the side seams.

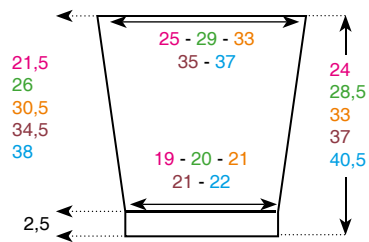
Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams.

Step 5: Join the neckband around the neck, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.
