Expert level



Back-and-forth knitting

27 sts and 31 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch n° 1 (see chart for Back), using 3.5 mm needles
34 sts to 11 cm and 31 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch n° 2 (see chart for Front), using 3.5 mm needles
25 sts and 31 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch for sleeves, using 3.5 mm needles

Composition: 50% wool, 50% acrylic

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 3 mm and 3.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

1 cable needle

Yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Pattern rib n° 1 (see chart for Back)

Reverse stockinette stitch (rev st st)

Pattern rib n° 2 and n° 3 (see chart for Front)

Stockinette stitch (st st)

Pattern rib n° 4 (see chart for Sleeves)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 74 - 80 - 88 - 92 - 98 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, then purl 1 row on the wrong side and evenly increase 11 - 13 - 14 - 15 - 17 sts in this row.

Total: 85 - 93 - 102 - 107 - 115 sts

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and pattern st n° 1 (see chart for Back), beginning with the 5th - 1st - 2nd - 5th - 1st st in the chart.

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

Total: 69 - 77 - 82 - 91 - 99 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 33 - 37 - 41 - 44 - 48 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts 3 times and 5 sts once

5 sts 4 times

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

6 sts 4 times

7 sts 4 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, bind off the center 15 - 17 - 20 - 23 - 23 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts twice.

Finish the other side of the neck.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 74 - 80 - 88 - 92 - 98 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, then purl 1 row on the wrong side and evenly increase 19 - 19 - 19 - 19 - 21 sts in this row.

Total: 93 - 99 - 107 - 111 - 119 sts

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and work in pattern st (see chart for Front) as follows:

10 - 10 - 13 - 13 - 17 sts in rev st st, then 33 sts in pattern st n° 2, 7 - 13 - 15 - 19 - 19 sts in st st, 41 sts in pattern st n° 3 and 2 - 2 - 5 - 5 - 9 sts in rev st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

Total: 77 - 83 - 87 - 95 - 103 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 31 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 15 - 17 - 19 - 21 - 21 sts, then finish on 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

Step 5: When your work measures 33 - 37 - 41 - 44 - 48 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 5 sts 3 times

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

6 sts 3 times and 7 sts once

7 sts 3 times and 8 sts once

Finish the other side of the neck.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 50 - 52 - 54 - 56 - 58 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and pattern st (see chart for Sleeves).

Step 3: Increase on each edge, keeping the pattern st correct as you increase:

every 12 rows, inc 1 st twice, then every 10 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 7 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 7 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

Total: 60 - 70 - 80 - 84 - 90 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 23.5 - 28 - 32.5 - 36.5 - 40 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts 3 times and 4 sts once

5 sts twice, 4 sts 3 times and 5 sts once

6 sts once, 5 sts 4 times and 6 sts once

6 sts twice, 5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

7 sts once, 6 sts twice, 5 sts once, 6 sts once and 7 sts once

Bind off the remaining 16 sts.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 82 - 86 - 92 - 96 - 96 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm.

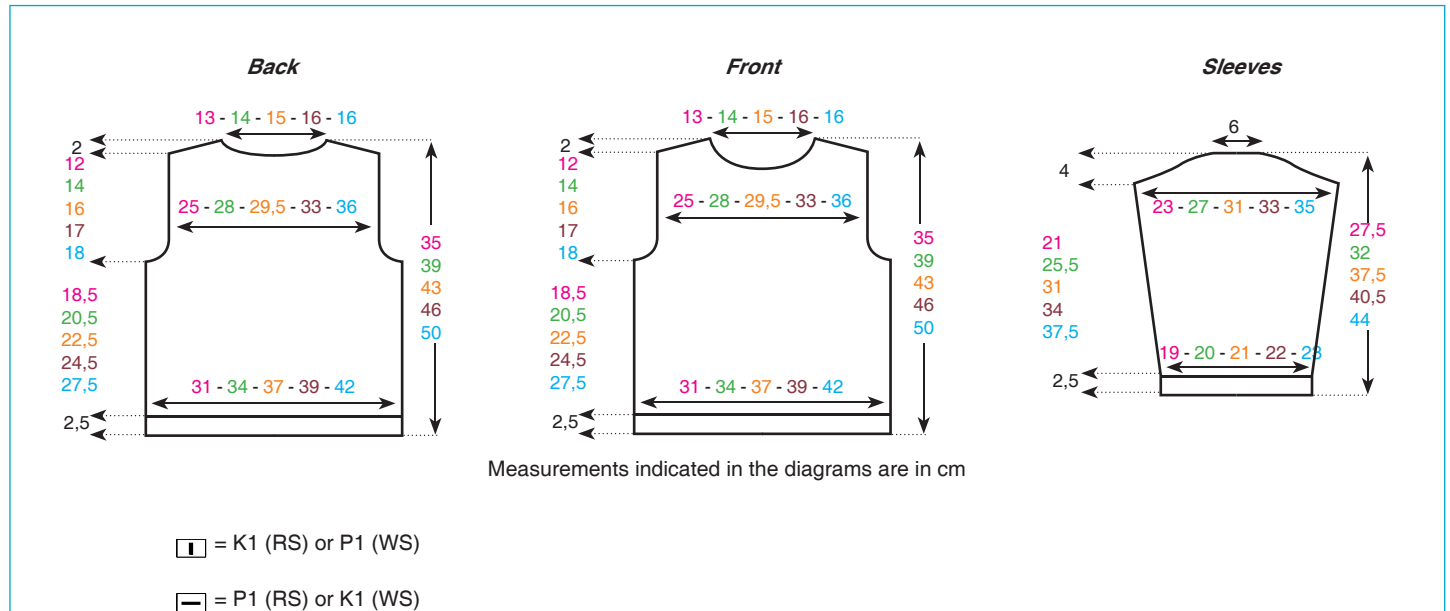
Step 2: Knit 1 row on the right side, then work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 3: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders, sides and sleeves.



☒ = 3 sts crossed to the right (RS): sl2 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, K1, then knit the 2 sts on the cable needle

☒ = 3 sts crossed to the left (RS): sl1 onto a cable needle placed in front of your work, K2, then knit the st on the cable needle

☒ = 3 sts (K2/P1) crossed to the left (RS): sl2 onto a cable needle placed in front of your work, P1, then knit the 2 sts on the cable needle

☒ = 3 sts (P1/K2) crossed to the right (RS): sl1 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, K2, then purl the st on the cable needle

☒ = 3 sts (K1/K2) crossed to the right (RS): sl1 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, K2, then knit the st on the cable needle

☒ = 3 sts (K2/K1) crossed to the left (RS): sl2 onto a cable needle placed in front of your work, K1, then knit the 2 sts on the cable needle

☒ = 5 sts crossed to the right (RS): sl3 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, K2, slip the 3rd st on the cable needle back onto the left needle and knit this st behind the 2 sts on the cable needle, then knit the 2 sts on the cable needle

☒ = 6 sts crossed to the right (RS): sl3 onto a cable needle placed behind your work, K3, then knit the 3 sts on the cable needle

Chart for pattern st n°1 (Back)

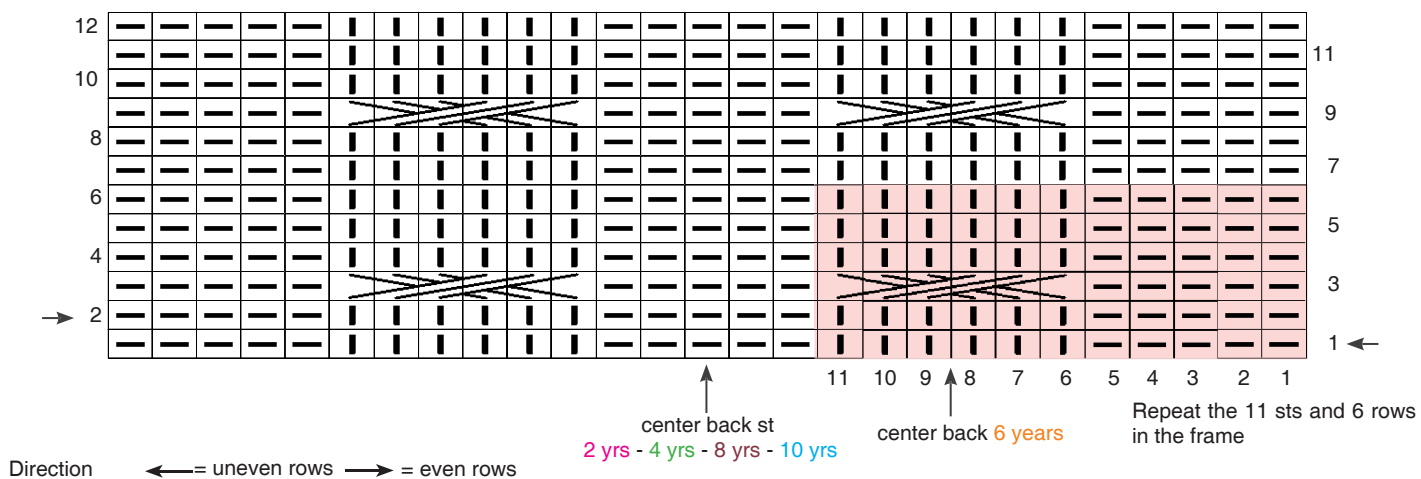


Chart for pattern st (Sleeves)

The chart shows the large size

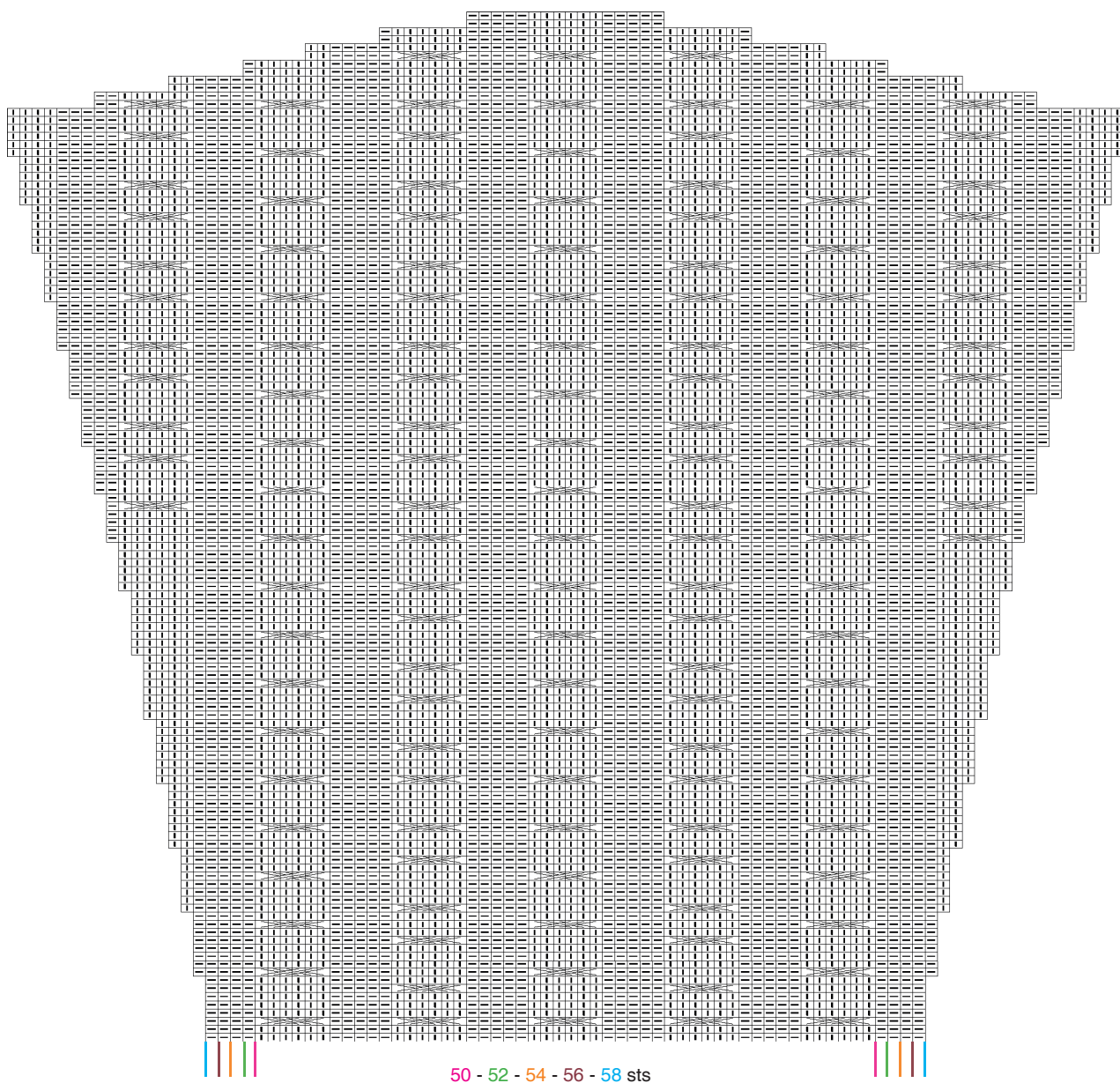


Chart for pattern st (Front)
