Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

27 sts and 37 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch using 3 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P.SUPER BABY	ORCHIDÉE AMETHYSTE	5 1	6 1	8 1	9 1	10 1

Composition: 70% acrylic, 30% lambswool

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle
Spool knitter, ref: 070117
5 - 5 - 6 - 6 - 6 x 12 mm pearlized buttons, color ROSE, ref: 0701982260

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Pattern stitch (see chart)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ORCHIDÉE, cast on 85 - 93 - 101 - 107 - 115 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K1.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and pattern st (see chart); begin with the 17th - 13th - 9th - 6th - 2nd st in the chart and increase 1 st at the beginning of the 1st row.

Total: 86 - 94 - 102 - 108 - 116 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, place a stitch marker on each edge to indicate the armholes.

Step 4: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts 4 times and 6 sts once
5 sts once and 6 sts 4 times
6 sts 4 times and 7 sts once
6 sts twice and 7 sts 3 times
7 sts 3 times and 8 sts twice

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 20 - 22 - 24 - 26 - 26 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off: 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once - 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once - 4 sts once and 2 sts twice - 4 sts once and 2 sts twice - 4 sts once and 2 sts twice

Step 5: Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ORCHIDÉE, cast on 41 - 45 - 49 - 51 - 55 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm, beginning the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and pattern st (see chart); begin with the 2nd st in the chart and increase 1 - 1 st at the end of the 1st row.

Total: 41 - 45 - 49 - 52 - 56 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, place a marker on the left edge to indicate the armhole.

Step 4: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

8 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once
9 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once
9 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once
10 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once
10 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

Step 5: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the left edge, bind off:

5 sts 4 times and 6 sts once
5 sts once and 6 sts 4 times
6 sts 4 times and 7 sts once
6 sts twice and 7 sts 3 times
7 sts 3 times and 8 sts twice

Step 6: Work the Left Front, reversing all the shaping and beginning the pattern st as for the Back.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ORCHIDÉE, cast on 52 - 54 - 56 - 60 - 62 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3 mm needles and pattern st (see chart); begin with the 13th - 12th - 11th - 9th - 8th st in the chart and increase 1 st at the beginning and end of the 1st row.

Total: 54 - 56 - 58 - 62 - 64 sts

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 28 rows, inc 1 st twice
every 14 rows, inc 1 st twice, then every 12 rows, inc 1 st 5 times
every 10 rows, inc 1 st 10 times, 8 rows higher, inc 1 st once
12 rows higher, inc 1 st once, then every 10 rows, inc 1 st 11 times
every 10 rows, inc 1 st 12 times, then every 8 rows, inc 1 st twice

Total: 58 - 70 - 80 - 86 - 92 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 24.5 - 29 - 33.5 - 37.5 - 41 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ORCHIDÉE, cast on 91 - 97 - 105 - 111 - 111 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: Knit 1 row on the right side, then work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ORCHIDÉE, cast on 105 - 117 - 129 - 139 - 149 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2; then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

Step 2: Work another band in the same way and in the 3rd row, make 5 - 5 - 6 - 6 - 6 buttonholes (= yo, K2tog). Make the 1st buttonhole at 4 sts from the edge and the following buttonholes at intervals of 22 - 24 - 22 - 24 - 26 sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body between the marked sts at the Back and front sections.

Step 3: Sew the side seams.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams.

Step 5: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

Step 6: Join the button bands along the front sections and neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

Step 7: Sew the buttons.

Step 8: Using the spool knitter and AMETHYSTE, make 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 bows as follows: For each bow, make a band of length 20 cm (long enough to tie) and form a bow (about 5 cm wide and 3 cm high; unravel a few rows if necessary to obtain these measurements). Position the bow on the button band, centering it with the buttonholes and holding it in place with several sts through the middle (see photo).
