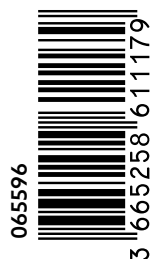

Easy level



YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P. INUIT	CANELLE	4	4	5	6	7
P. COTON 3	ÉCUREUIL	1	1	1	1	1

STITCHES:

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit 1 row, purl 1 row
These 2 rows form the stitch.

Easy level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

11 sts and 15 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch, using P. INUIT and 6 mm needles

26 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch, using P. COTON 3 and 3 mm needles

Composition: 91% polyester, 9% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 3 mm and 6 mm knitting needles

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

30 - 35 - 35 - 40 - 45 cm zipper (not sold)

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit 1 row, purl 1 row

These 2 rows form the stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK AND FRONT SECTIONS

Step 1: Using 6 mm needles and CABAN or CANELLE, cast on 72 - 79 - 86 - 91 - 97 sts and work in st st for 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm.

Step 2: Shape the armholes. Divide your work into 3 parts as follows: Work the first 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 - 25 sts and leave them on a holder for the Right Front, then work the center 36 - 39 - 42 - 45 - 47 sts and leave them on a holder for the Back, then work the last 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 - 25 sts for the Left Front.

Left Front:

Step 3: Continue in st st on these 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 - 25 sts until your work measures 31 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 cm.

Step 4: Shape the neck. On the left edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

Total: 11 - 12 - 14 - 14 - 15 sts on the needle

Step 5: Bind off all the sts.

Right Front:

Step 6: Pick up the first 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 - 25 sts left on a holder and continue in st st until your work measures 31 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 cm.

Step 7: Shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

Total: 11 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 sts on the needle

Step 8: Bind off all the sts.

Back:

Step 9: Pick up the center 36 - 39 - 42 - 45 - 47 sts left on a holder and continue in st st until your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm.

Step 10: Bind off all the sts.

Step 11: Place a stitch marker after the 11th - 12th - 13th - 14th - 15th st from each edge to indicate the end of the shoulder seams.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 6 mm needles and CABAN or CANELLE, cast on 24 - 24 - 26 - 26 - 27 sts and work in st st.

Step 2: Increase 1 st at the beginning and end of the following rows:

9th, 17th, 25th and 31st rows

7th, 13th, 19th, 25th, 31st and 37th rows

9th, 15th, 21st, 27th, 33rd, 39th and 45th rows

9th, 15th, 21st, 27th, 33rd, 39th, 45th and 51st rows

7th, 13th, 19th, 25th, 31st, 37th, 43rd, 49th and 55th rows

Total: 32 - 36 - 40 - 42 - 45 sts

Step 3: Continue in st st until your work measures 24 - 28.5 - 33 - 37 - 40.5 cm. Bind off all the sts.

Locate the center of the sleeve and place a marker (point M).

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

COLLAR STAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and NAVAL or ÉCUREUIL, cast on 81 - 91 - 99 - 107 - 117 sts and work in st st for 2 cm.

Step 2: Bind off all the sts.

Make another band in the same way.

HOOD

Step 1: Using 6 mm needles and CABAN or CANELLE, cast on 50 - 52 - 56 - 60 - 62 sts and work in st st for 16 - 17 - 19 - 20 - 20 cm.

Step 2: Divide your work in half and leave the last 25 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 31 sts on a holder.

Step 3: Work on the first 25 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 31 sts and on each edge, bind off 1 st twice and 2 sts once.

Total: 17 - 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 20 - 21 - 23 - 24 - 24 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Step 5: Pick up the 25 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 31 sts left on a holder and work in st st. On each edge, bind off 1 st twice and 2 sts once.

Total: 17 - 18 - 20 - 22 - 23 sts

Step 6: When your work measures 20 - 21 - 23 - 24 - 24 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and front sections together with right sides facing. Sew the shoulder seams up to the stitch markers, using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Sew the sleeve seams, using concealed stitching and following the yellow lines in the diagram.

Step 3: Place the sleeve and the body side by side with the right sides facing. Place point M at the sleeve on point M at the shoulder seam. Join the sleeve to the body, using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram.

Join the other sleeve in the same way.

Step 4: Sew the hood in backstitch from point A to point B, following the orange lines in the diagram.

Step 5: Join the hood around the neck, matching points B and C and following the grey lines in the diagram.

Step 6: Sew the zipper along the front sections, following the purple lines in the diagram.

Step 7: Sew the 2 parts of the collar stand inside the front sections to hide the zipper seam.
