STITCHES:
Garter stitch: knit every row
K1/P1 rib

Easy level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

23 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm measured over garter stitch using 4 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	newborn	3 mths	6 mths	12 mths	18 mths
P. CARESSE	BRUNAUBURN	2	2	3	3	4

Composition: 51% acrylic microfibres, 49% acrylic

MATERIALS:

1 pair each of 3 mm and 4 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

Garter stitch: knit every row

K1/P1 rib: K1, P1 to the end of the row. In the next row, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a K1 or P1 above a P1 in the previous row).

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Begin with the left half-leg

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 14 - 16 - 18 - 20 - 22 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib (see STITCHES) until your work measures 1 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Change to 4 mm needles and garter st (see STITCHES), increasing 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 st at the beginning of the 1st row.

Total: 15 - 16 - 19 - 21 - 23 sts

Step 4: Increase 1 st as follows, in the:

7th and 13th rows on the left edge, 15th row on the right edge, 21st row on the left edge, 27th row on the right edge, 29th row on the left edge, 35th row on the right edge, 37th row on the left edge, and the 39th, 41st and 43rd rows on the right edge

11th row on the left edge, 19th row on the right edge, 21st and 31st rows on the left edge, 35th row on the right edge, 41st row on the left edge, 47th row on the right edge, 51st row on the left edge, and the 53rd, 55th and 57th rows on the right edge

13th row on the right edge, 21st row on the left edge, 25th and 37th rows on the right edge, 39th row on the left edge, 49th row on the right edge, 55th row on the left edge, 61st row on the right edge, 63rd and 67th rows on the left edge, and the 71st row on the right edge

15th row on the left edge, 25th row on the right edge, 29th and 43rd rows on the left edge, 45th row on the right edge, 57th row on the left edge, 63rd row on the right edge, 71st row on the left edge, and the 73rd, 79th and 83rd rows on the right edge

19th row on the left edge, 29th row on the right edge, 37th row on the left edge, 53rd row on BOTH edges, 69th row on the left edge, 75th row on the right edge, 85th row on the left edge, and the 87th, 95th and 99th rows on the right edge

Total: 26 - 27 - 30 - 32 - 34 sts

Step 5: Work in garter st until your work measures 11.5 - 15 - 18 - 21 - 25 cm from the beginning, then leave these sts on a holder.

Step 6: Work the right half-leg, reversing the shaping.

Step 7: Join both half-legs as follows:

Work the 26 - 27 - 30 - 32 - 34 sts for the 1st half-leg, cast on 2 sts for the gusset, then work the 26 - 27 - 30 - 32 - 34 sts for the 2nd half-leg.

Total: 54 - 56 - 62 - 66 - 70 sts on the needle

Step 8: Continue in garter st on all the sts; bind off 1 st at the beginning (knit the first 2 sts together) and at the end (knit the last 2 sts together) of the following rows:

57th, 69th, 81st and 95th rows

71st, 85th, 99th and 113th rows

93rd, 109th, 125th and 141st rows

101st, 117th, 133rd and 149th rows

117th, 133rd, 149th and 167th rows

Total: 46 - 48 - 54 - 58 - 62 sts

Step 9: Work in garter st until your work measures 26.5 - 31 - 35 - 40 - 45 cm from the beginning.

Step 10: Change to 3 mm needles and work in K1/P1 rib until your work measures 31.5 - 36 - 40 - 45 - 50 cm from the beginning, then bind off.

FRONT

Work as for the Back.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and Front together with right sides facing, then sew the side seams using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagrams.

Step 2: Sew the inside leg, using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram.

Step 3: Fold the top rib in half inwards and sew with concealed stitching.

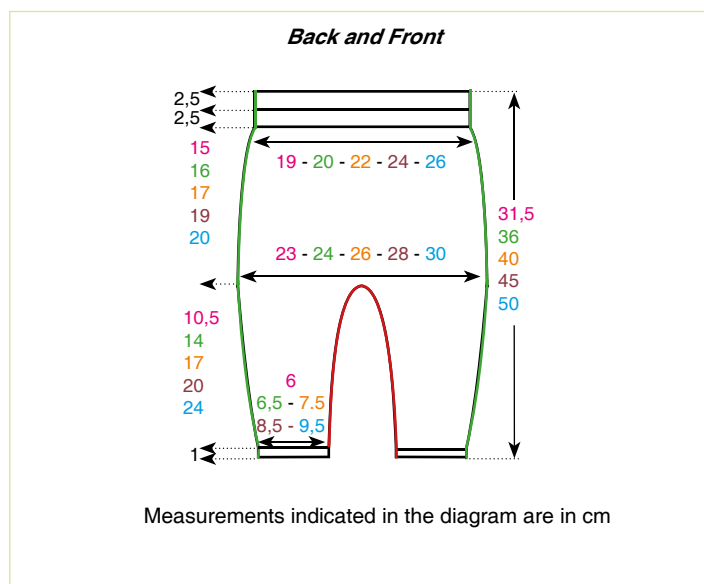
