### STITCHES:

K1/P1 circular rib: alternate K1, P1

K1/P1 rib in rows

Circular stockinette stitch (st st)

Straight stitch and stem stitch embroidery

### TENSION SQUARE

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch, using 4.5 mm needles and 1 strand each of P. MERINOS 3.5 and P. MOHAIR SOIE worked together

**Composition:** 67% Merino wool, 23% mohair, 10% silk

### Hat size:

3 months: 37 cm circumference x 14 cm height

6 months: 41 cm circumference x 15 cm height

12 months: 43 cm circumference x 16 cm height

18 months: 45 cm circumference x 16 cm height

24 months: 45 cm circumference x 16 cm height

Suitable for head sizes 41 - 45 - 47 - 49 - 49 cm

### MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

4 mm and 4.5 mm circular knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

### Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

**K1/P1 circular rib: alternate K1, P1**

**K1/P1 rib in rows:** K1, P1 to the end of the row. In the following rows, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a K1 or P1 above a P1 in the previous row).

**Circular stockinette stitch (st st):** knit all the sts  
**Straight stitch and stem stitch embroidery**

## INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

### HAT

**Step 1:** Using a 4 mm circular needle and 1 strand of P. MERINOS 3.5 with P. MOHAIR SOIE worked together, cast on 74 - 82 - 86 - 90 - 90 sts.

**Step 2:** Close the round (i.e. continue by inserting the needle in the 1<sup>st</sup> cast-on st) and place a marker on this st to indicate the start of each round.

**Step 3:** Work 4 rounds in K1/P1 circular rib (see STITCHES).

**Step 4:** Change to a 4.5 mm needle and work in circular st st (see STITCHES).

**Step 5:** When your work measures 14 - 15 - 16 - 16 - 16 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

### TIES

**Step 1:** Using a 4 mm circular needle and the 2 strands together, cast on 45 sts and work in rows of K1/P1 rib (see STITCHES), beginning and ending the 1<sup>st</sup> row with K2.

**Step 2:** Work 3 rows in K1/P1 rib, then bind off all the sts.

**Step 3:** Work the other tie in the same way.

### MAKE UP

**Step 1:** Turn the hat inside out and sew the top using concealed stitching.

**Step 2:** Sew the ties on either side of the hat, positioning them below the K1/P1 rib. Turn the hat right side out.

**Step 3:** Using a length of grey yarn (e.g. P. IMAGINAIRE 3.5 in ANTHRACITE as shown here), embroider the nose in straight st and the whiskers in stem st (see diagram).

**Step 4:** Pin the hat as shown in the diagram, then turn it inside out and sew an overlock seam to form the ears.

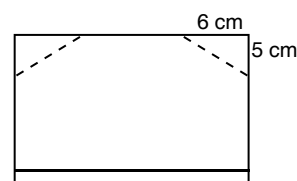
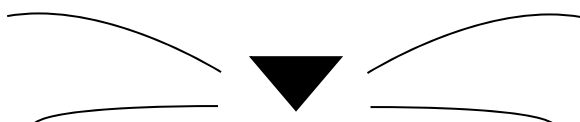
