TENSION SQUARE

24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using 3.5 mm needles

24 sts and 52 rows to 10 cm measured over garter stitch using 3.5 mm needles

Composition: 100% Merino wool

SNOOD SIZE

Width 39 - 41 - 43 - 45 - 47 cm

Total height: 15 cm

HAT SIZE

Width 36.5 - 40 - 40 - 43.5 - 43.5 cm

Total height: 16 - 17 - 18 - 18 - 18 cm

Suitable for head sizes 41 - 45 - 47 - 49 - 49 cm

MATERIALS:

1 pair of 3.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

3.5 mm circular needle (for the hat)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

K2tog = knit 2 sts together

Garter stitch in rows: knit every row

Circular garter stitch: alternately knit 1 row, purl 1 row

K1/P1 circular rib: alternate K1/P1 in each round

Circular stockinette stitch: knit all the sts

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HAT AND SNOOD

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

SNOOD

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 95 - 100 - 105 - 110 - 115 sts and work in rows of garter st for 15 cm.

Step 2: Bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP FOR SNOOD

Step 1: Weave in the ends.

Step 2: Give the snood a twist, then sew with an invisible seam.

HAT

Step 1: Using a 3.5 mm circular needle, cast on 88 - 96 - 96 - 104 - 104 sts and work in K1/P1 circular rib for 1 cm.

Step 2: Change to circular garter st and work for 5 cm.

Step 3: Change to circular st st.

Step 4: When your work measures 11.5 - 12.5 - 13.5 - 13.5 - 13.5 cm from the beginning, place 8 stitch markers at intervals of 11 - 12 - 12 - 13 - 13 sts.

In the next round, K2tog before each marker.

Total: 80 - 88 - 88 - 96 - 96 sts

Work 1 round without decreases.

Repeat these 2 rounds 5 more times.

Total: 40 - 48 - 48 - 56 - 56 sts

In the following round, K2tog to the end.

Total: 20 - 24 - 24 - 28 - 28 sts

Work 1 round without decreases.

In the following round, K2tog to the end.

Total: 10 - 12 - 12 - 14 - 14 sts

Thread a strand of yarn through the remaining sts and pull tight.

MAKE UP FOR HAT

Step 1: Weave in the ends.

Version B: Step 2: Make a bow as follows: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 20 sts and work in rows of garter st for 4 cm, then bind off all the sts.

Wind a length of yarn around the middle of this band, then sew the bow on the garter st (see photo).
