STITCHES:

Stockinette stitch (st st)

Stockinette stitch stripes

Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

14 sts and 23 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch or stockinette stitch stripes using 5 mm needles

Composition: 100% polyester

MATERIALS:

1 pair each of 4 mm and 5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch holder

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 x 14 mm buttons, ref: 054579

STITCHES:

Stockinette stitch (st st)

Stockinette stitch stripes: 14 - 16 - 18 - 20 - 22 rows in MIEL, 18 - 20 - 22 - 24 - 26 rows in AMANDE, end with VERT EMPIRE

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK AND FRONT SECTIONS

Worked in 1 piece without side seams

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and MIEL, cast on 71 - 75 - 79 - 87 - 91 sts and work tightly in st st for 2 cm (4 rows).

Step 2: Change to 5 mm needles and st st stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 12 - 14 - 16 - 18 - 19 cm from the beginning, divide it into 3 parts.

Work 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 - 22 sts and leave these sts on a holder for the Right Front, then bind off the following 4 sts, work the center 29 - 31 - 33 - 37 - 39 sts and leave these sts on a holder for the Back. then bind off the following 4 sts, work the 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 - 22 sts for the Left Front.

LEFT FRONT

Step 1: Continue on the last 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 - 22 sts. On the right edge, bind off 1 st twice (for the armhole).

Total: 15 - 16 - 17 - 19 - 20 sts

Step 2: When your work measures 20 - 23 - 26 - 28 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the left edge, bind off:

5 sts once and 2 sts twice

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

6 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Step 3: When your work measures 22 - 25 - 28 - 31 - 33 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the right edge, bind off:

3 sts twice

3 sts twice

3 sts once and 4 sts once

4 sts twice

4 sts twice

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Continue on the first 17 - 18 - 19 - 21 - 22 sts. On the left edge, bind off 1 st twice (for the armhole).

Total: 15 - 16 - 17 - 19 - 20 sts

Step 2: When your work measures 20 - 23 - 26 - 28 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

5 sts once and 2 sts twice

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

6 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Step 3: When your work measures 22 - 25 - 28 - 31 - 33 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the left edge, bind off:

3 sts twice

3 sts twice

3 sts once and 4 sts once

4 sts twice

4 sts twice

BACK

Step 1: Continue on the center 29 - 31 - 33 - 37 - 39 sts left on a holder. On each edge, bind off 1 st twice (for the armholes).

Total: 25 - 27 - 29 - 33 - 35 sts

Step 2: When your work measures 22 - 25 - 28 - 31 - 33 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts twice

3 sts twice

3 sts once and 4 sts once

4 sts twice

4 sts twice

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 13 - 15 - 15 - 17 - 19 sts, then finish 1 side at a time.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 5 mm needles and VERT EMPIRE, cast on 23 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 sts and work in st st.

Step 2: When your work measures 3 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each edge to indicate the turnback.

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

8 rows higher, inc 1 st once, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 4 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 4 times, 6 rows higher, inc 1 st once

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

Total: 29 - 31 - 33 - 37 - 39 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 13 - 17.5 - 19.5 - 22.5 - 24.5 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice and 3 sts once

3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once, 2 sts once and 3 sts once

4 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once, 2 sts once and 3 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 4 sts once

Bind off the remaining 9 sts.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

HOOD

Step 1: Using 5 mm needles and VERT EMPIRE, cast on 54 - 58 - 60 - 64 - 64 sts and work in st st.

Step 2: When your work measures 3 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each edge to indicate the turnback.

Step 3: When your work measures 16 - 17 - 18 - 19.5 - 20.5 cm from the beginning, halve your work and finish 1 side at a time.

On each edge, bind off 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 3 sts once.

Bind off the remaining 13 - 15 - 16 - 18 - 18 sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

Step 2: Sew the sleeve seams, reversing the seam over 4 cm at the bottom for the 3 cm turnback; then sew the turnback.

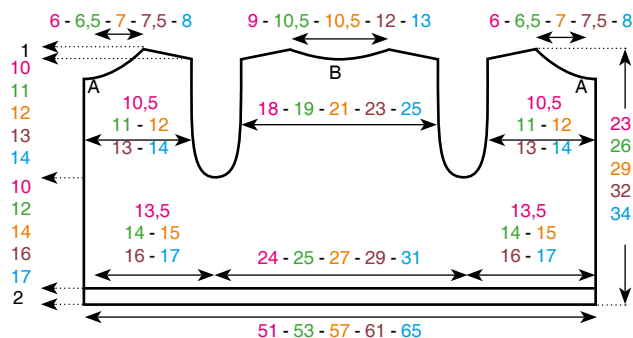
Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 4: Sew the back of the hood (points B and C). Then fold the first 3 cm (indicated by the markers) to the outside and sew the hood around the neck; leave the first 2 sts on the front sections free and sew the folded turnback into the seam.

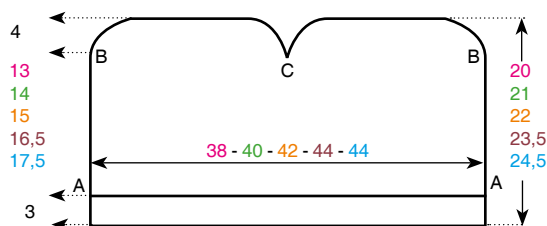
Step 5: Make 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 buttonholes on the Left Front by widening the 2nd st. Make the 1st buttonhole 1.5 cm below the neck and the other buttonholes at intervals of 5 - 6 - 5.5 - 6 - 6.5 cm.

Step 6: Sew the buttons.

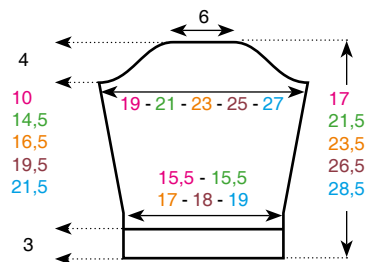
Back and front sections
